- **Pat Bergeson:** Versatile guitarist and harmonica player, known for collaborations with Chet Atkins and Lyle Lovett, contributes electric guitar and harmonica.
- **Dane Bryant:** Keyboardist and producer with credits including Olivia Newton-John and Clint Black, provides keyboards and piano.
- **Alison Prestwood:** Renowned bassist with a portfolio spanning Faith Hill to Peter Frampton, plays bass guitar.
- **Steve Brewster:** Veteran drummer whose rhythms have backed artists like Jewel and Dierks Bentley, handles drums and percussion.
- **Steve Hinson:** Master of the pedal steel guitar, contributing to works by George Jones and Dolly Parton, adds pedal steel guitar.
